

# Electric Vehicle Charging

## How does the public electric vehicle charging scheme work?

The Electric Vehicle (EV) charging scheme is supported by the Department of Environment, Food and Agriculture, (DEFA).

To gain access to the service you must collect an EV Service Key, from our Headquarters at Ballacottier Business Park or the IOM Welcome Centre at Douglas Sea Terminal. You will be asked to provide your contact details, vehicle model and registration.



## How does it operate?

- This is a **FREE** service
- Each charging point has two connection points
- Vehicles must be parked within the boundary of the designated electric vehicle parking bays
- Each charging station provides two blue 3 pin, 230v 16 amp sockets, which allows two cars to connect at any one time
- Charging stations in Castletown, Ramsey & MU Headquarters offer a "Type 2" 32 amp solution
- Only the power lead provided by the vehicle manufacturer is permitted to be connected to one of the available sockets
- You do not need a permit to use the service, you only need to register
- You will need to pay for normal parking charges

## How can I apply for the Electric Vehicle tariff for my home?

- We offer domestic customers an EV tariff to charge their own electric vehicle (exc. Hybrids) licenced for public highways. You can use plug in cars, motorcycles and mopeds which have a minimum of a 10kW motor
- We offer an off peak rate, of 8.75p per unit plus VAT, for charging between the hours of midnight and 7am GMT. During the day time units will be charged at the standard 16.25p per unit plus VAT
