

ELECTRIC VEHICLE (EV) TARIFF

What is the Electric Vehicle Tariff and do I qualify?

The EV Tariff is a two-rate tariff and is subject to Direct Debit payments only. It is available to Domestic customers who own an Electric Vehicle and charge that vehicle at their home. To qualify for this tariff the Electric Vehicle must be 100% electric with a minimum battery power rating of 10kW (hybrid vehicles do not qualify). Also the vehicle must be Manx registered at the applicants address.

What are the unit charges and two-rate time periods?

- Standard electricity (Rate 1) units are charged at the standard Domestic rate 16.3 pence per unit
- Off-Peak electricity (Rate 2) units are charged at 8.9 pence per unit and applied for a 7 hour period between the hours of 00:00 and 07:00 GMT. The times do not alter with British Summer Time (BST) so the off-peak hours effectively become 01:00 to 08:00 BST
- Our Standard Domestic Standing Charge of 19.5 pence per day is applicable
- Customers can benefit from further discounts by signing up to our e-billing service
- To take maximum advantage of the off-peak unit rate, customers should charge their Electric Vehicle between the off-peak hours
- Please note that it is the customers responsibility to synchronise their off-peak usage with the time displayed on the meters internal clock

What are the financial benefits of the Electric Vehicle Tariff?

During the off-peak hours, all of the electricity that you use within your domestic property will be charged at the cheaper rate. In addition to charging your Electric Vehicle, you can also take advantage of the reduced rate to use other appliances. For example appliances such as a washing machine, tumble dryer and dishwasher can all be set to switch on during this period to take advantage of the cheaper rate.

I meet the criteria - What steps do I need to take to apply for the Tariff?

- 1** You will need to complete an Electricity Network Enquiry form (ENE). They are available to download from our website or by contacting us.
- 2** We will process your application and undertake studies to determine if any alterations are required to our network or your service cable. Should we need to make any alterations, there may be an additional charge dependent on the complexity of work involved.
- 3** We will send a formal quotation letter to you identifying work required by ourselves, making clear the terms and conditions and detailing work requirements of your contractor.
- 4** Should you wish to accept our terms and conditions detailed in the quotation, you will need to return the following documentation to us:
 - A signed Acceptance Letter with payment
 - If internal wiring is required a Test Certificate & Connection form which **MUST** be completed by a Part-P registered electrician
 - A copy of your IOM Government vehicle registration documents for your Electric Vehicle which must be registered at your address
- 5** We will contact you to agree a convenient time to complete network alterations and install the new metering equipment.

Where can I find advice on the best type of charger for me?

Any Part-P registered electrical contractor on the Island can provide design advice for Electric Vehicle charging and alterations to your wiring installation.
