*Switch off stand-by. An average 9-16% of a home's electricity is used by stand-by*

*A shorter shower saves. Even better, fit a water saving eco shower head*

*Set up a direct debit for your electricity payments and save £1.00 per bill*

*Lower thermostats in unoccupied rooms to save on heating bills*

*If you use the washing machine one wash less per week it saves £9.00 per year*

*Switch your light bulbs to L.E.D for an average 18% saving over CFLs*
